Often ingenious and strangely beautiful, each of the 220 objects in this book is depicted in a color photograph, flanked by explanatory remarks from its maker. Among the creations shown here are a beer trolley made from a shopping cart, a rocking horse designed to look like a motor bike, a handheld dispenser for barbed wire, a dog kennel made from a plastic oil drum, a metal detector made from radio parts, and a child's candle-powered corn grill. 256.
